


Zoning Requirements: Prior to CAR review, it is the responsibility of the applicant to determine if zoning approval is required and application materials should be prepared in compliance with zoning.





Note:

A thick concrete parge of varying depths was added to the facade and A thick concrete parge of varying depths was added to the facade and painted yellow. White accent frames constitute thicker areas of the parge. The parge liself is bonded with the original brick making removal very costly if not impossible without significant damage to the brick.

Proposed Strategies







Note:

The majority of the parge will remain in fact. However, the "frame" elements will be ground down and a thin parge will create a smooth surface allowing for the reintroduction of the shapes of some original elements. The final parged surface will be painted one color.




Burton Avenue




Perspective from N 22nd Street 9




Level 1 Floor Plan 10







Proposed Building Elevations 12
