THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That sections 9-58, 9-59, 9-60, and 9-124 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015) be and are hereby **amended** and reordained as follows:

Sec. 9-58. Polling places.

Pursuant to Code of Virginia, §§ 24.2-310 and 24.2-310.1, the polling places for each of the precincts established in this article shall be as follows:

Sec. 9-59. Precinct 101.

Election Precinct 101 shall be described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the 1970 corporation line and [Libbie Avenue] Boatwright Drive; thence in a [southward] northwestward, then eastward direction along the [centerline of Libbie Avenue] 1970 corporation line to its intersection with the centerline of [Guthrie Avenue; thence in a westward direction along the centerline of Guthrie Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Maple Avenue; thence in a southward direction along the centerline of Maple Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Fergusson Road; thence in a northwestward direction along the centerline of Fergusson Road to its intersection with the centerline of Somerset Avenue; thence in a southward direction along the centerline of Somerset Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Grove Avenue; thence in a westward direction along the centerline of Grove Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Saint Catherine's Lane; thence in a southward direction along the centerline of Saint Catherine's Lane to its intersection with the centerline of Cary Street Road; thence in an eastward direction along the centerline of Cary Street Road Three Chopt Road; thence in a southeastward direction along the centerline of Three Chopt Road to its intersection with the centerline of Towana Road; thence in a southeastward direction along the centerline of Towana Road to the point at which it becomes Three Chopt Road East Leg; thence in a southeast direction along the centerline of Three Chopt Road East Leg to its intersection with the centerline of Grove Avenue; thence in a westward direction along the centerline of Grove Avenue to its intersection with Three Chopt Road; thence in a

southeastward direction along the centerline of Three Chopt Road to its intersection with the centerline of River Road; thence in a westward direction along the centerline of River Road to its intersection with the 1970 corporation line; thence in a generally northward direction along the 1970 corporation line to its intersection with the centerline of [Libbie Avenue] Boatwright Drive, the point of beginning.

Sec. 9-60. Precinct 102.

Election Precinct 102 shall be described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of the 1970 corporation line and the centerline of [Libbie] Maple Avenue; thence in a southward direction along the centerline of [Libbie] Maple Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Guthrie Avenue; thence in [a westward] an eastward direction along the centerline of Guthrie Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of [Maple] Libbie Avenue; thence in a southward direction along the centerline of [Maple] Libbie Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of [Fergusson Road; thence in a northwestward direction along the centerline of Fergusson Road to its intersection with the centerline of Somerset Avenue; thence in a southward direction along the centerline of Somerset Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Grove Avenue; thence in a westward direction along the centerline of Grove Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of [Saint Catherine's Lane Three Chopt Road; thence in a southward direction along the centerline of [Saint Catherine's Lane] Three Chopt Road to its intersection with the centerline of Cary Street Road; thence in an eastward direction along the

centerline of Cary Street Road to its intersection with the centerline of Tuckahoe Boulevard; thence in a northward direction along the centerline of Tuckahoe Boulevard to its intersection with the centerline of Bewdley Road; thence in a westward direction along the centerline of Bewdley Road to its intersection with the centerline of Matoaka Road; thence in a northward direction along the centerline of Matoaka Road to its intersection with the centerline of Patterson Avenue; thence in an eastward direction along the centerline of Patterson Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Dunbar Street; thence in a northward direction along the centerline of Dunbar Street to its intersection with the centerline of the 1970 corporation line; thence in a westward direction along the centerline of the 1970 corporation line to its intersection with the centerline of [Libbie] Maple Avenue, the point of beginning.

Sec. 9-124. District precinct assignments.

For the purpose of the election of persons to the City Council and the School Board, the precincts shall be assigned to districts as follows:

- (1) Precincts 101 through [114] 115, District 1.
- (2) Precincts 203 through [213] 214, District 2.
- (3) Precincts 301 through 310, District 3.
- (4) Precincts 402 through 414, District 4.
- (5) Precincts 501 through 510, District 5.
- (6) Precincts 602 through 610, District 6.
- (7) Precincts 701 through 708, District 7.
- (8) Precincts 802 through 814, District 8.

- (9) Precincts 902 through 911, District 9.
- § 2. That chapter 9, article III of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015) be and is hereby amended and reordained by **adding therein a new** section numbered 9-67.1 as follows:

Sec. 9-67.1. Precinct 115.

Election Precinct 115 shall be described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the 1970 corporation line and Maple Avenue; thence in a southward direction along the centerline of Maple Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Guthrie Avenue; thence in an eastward direction along the centerline of Guthrie Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Libbie Avenue; thence in a southward direction along the centerline of Libbie Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Grove Avenue; thence in a westward direction along the centerline of Grove Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Three Chopt Road East Leg; thence in a northward direction along the centerline of Three Chopt Road East Leg to the point at which it becomes Towana Road; thence in a northward direction along the centerline of Towana Road to its intersection with the centerline of Three Chopt Road; thence in an northwestward direction along the centerline of Three Chopt Road to its intersection with the 1970 corporation line; thence in a generally eastward direction along the 1970 corporation line to its intersection with the centerline of Maple Avenue, the point of beginning.

§ 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.

ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY

Ordinance to amend and reordain City Code §9-58, which assigns polling places in the city, to relocate and establish a new polling location for Precincts 101 and 102, and to establish a polling place for a new precinct 115; to amend and reordain §9-59 and 9-60 which describe the boundaries for precincts 101 and 102; to add a new City Code § 9-124 which assigns precincts to districts to assign the new precinct 115 to District 1.

BACKGROUND

This Ordinance proposes to split one half of the current precinct 101 into a new precinct 115, reassign voters along the boundary between existing precinct 102 and the new precinct 115 and to establish new polling places for precincts 101, the proposed precinct 115 and 102. The new polling place for precinct 101 would be the Jepson Alumni Center at the University of Richmond, 49 Crenshaw Way. The new polling place for precinct 102 would be St. Giles Church, 5200

Grove Avenue. The polling place for the new precinct 115 would be the Fire Engine House at 311 Maple Avenue. The polling place for precinct 101 is being relocated because the current location is a private facility which has chosen to no longer be a polling place. The polling place for precinct 102 is being relocated back to where it was a number of years ago in order to provide a polling place for the new precinct 115. A new precinct 115 is being created by splitting precinct 101 because the size of precinct 101 is expected to be larger than recommended by the 2020 presidential election. Any changes to precincts to accommodate the presidential voting population must be done no later than February 1, 2019 as the General Assembly just enacted legislation to freeze precinct boundaries at that time. The proposed new polling places for 102 is outside the precinct boundaries, but is just across the street from and within one mile of the precinct as required by §24.2-310 of the Code of Virginia. All three proposed polling places are accessible for persons with disabilities. Upon adoption of the ordinance, all 4,723 registered voters that would be affected by these changes will be sent notices informing them of the change at least two weeks before the June primary election.

The cost of this mailing is approximately \$4,800. The Office of the General Registrar does not have an appropriation for this cost as the immediate need for this change was not foreseen, but it is essential and mandatory. The Office of the General Registrar requested funds in its FY 18-19 budget submission to split precinct 101, but the change must be made earlier due to the loss of the polling place. Depending upon the final costs of the June primary, the agency may be able to absorb this expenditure.
