## ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY

The patron requests that a resolution be drafted requesting that CAO develop an appeals process that specifically allows for administrative appeals of civil penalties issued pursuant to City Code Section 11-105(e).

The resolution should include a request that the CAO report the recommendations to City Council in 60 days.

#### BACKGROUND

Property owners and tenants are frequently issued citations for violations environment codes with civil penalties. Currently, there is no appeals process in place for the penalties established in Section 11-105(e). The purpose of this resolution is to consider establishing a clear process that allows property owners to contest and appeal civil penalties while protecting the due process rights of property owners and renters.
