Sec. 12-37. Disposition of certain meals tax proceeds.

When the City collects or receives meals taxes levied pursuant to section 26-669, the Director of Finance shall credit [one-fifth] 20.3 percent of the amount so collected to the special reserve assigned to support public schools in the city established by subsection (b)(1) of section
