
Request – Handrails for front steps


- Attached are three pictures.

Picture 3 - Drawings of the railings. The drawings were done by Byron Pennington of Small Axe Forge. The posts (balusters) would be made of 1.5 inch square steel and the pickets would be made of 3/4 inch steel. The top cap would be made of 2 ½ inches wide molded steel handrail. All steel would be painted with two coats of DTM satin black acrylic paint.
