One member shall be nominated by the Board of Directors of the Monroe Park Conservancy to represent the conservancy, one member shall be nominated by the Board of Directors of the Maymont Foundation to represent the foundation, and one member shall be nominated by the Board of Directors of the EnRichmond Foundation to represent the foundation. One member shall be selected from the staff of the city's Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities. One member shall be selected from each of the nine Councilmanic Districts of the City, with each such member to be a resident of the Councilmanic District nominated by the Council member representing such Councilmanic District fail to nominate a resident of the Councilmanic District within 90 days of a vacancy, whether created by the expiration of a term or otherwise, in the seat assigned to that Councilmanic District, any Council member may nominate a resident of any Councilmanic District to fill such vacancy.

- g. A parent representative who receives or has received services for the representative's child or foster child through one or more of the agencies participating in the Community Policy and Management Team.
- h. A representative of a private organization located within the City that (i) serves children and families in the City, (ii) has a provider contract with the City's Comprehensive Services Act office, (iii) is in compliance with its provider contract and (iv) is properly licensed by the Commonwealth as a provider of services to children and families. If this representative's organization fails to remain in good standing pursuant to its contract with the City's Comprehensive Services Act office, then the representative's seat on the team will become vacant immediately upon the occurrence of such failure, and the Council will appoint a new representative from a different eligible organization.
- i. An elected official or an appointed official or the designee thereof from the City Council.

I have also been a part of smaller pilots aimed at system's change within the Richmond community, such as 30 Days to Family, to help foster youth connect with relatives within 30 days of entering care and Grief Camp, a partnership with Comfort Zone Camp to help foster youth grieve their losses of being removed from their birth family.

I received an MA in Psychology from the College of William and Mary and went on to receive an MSW from VCU. I received my LCSW in 2007. Other experiences include a graduate from the Emerging Leaders Program 2014, and the Executive Leadership Program with the Alliance 2017-2018.
