THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That section 29-184 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015) be and is hereby **amended** and reordained as follows:

**Sec. 29-184. Stops.**

All vehicles operated under this article shall stop for the purpose of taking on or letting off passengers at such points or places as shall be designated by the Chief of Police. All such points or places shall be clearly marked by suitable signs, to be placed and maintained at the cost and expense of the City. Notwithstanding the foregoing, no point or place at which vehicles operated under this article may stop for the purpose of taking on or letting off passengers shall be located on North Davis Avenue between its intersection with West Broad Street and its intersection with

**ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY**

The patron requests that legislation be drafted for Council's consideration regarding the planned installation of a GRTC bus stop at N. Davis Avenue between W. Broad Street and W. Grace Street; and 2.) the installation of the proposed bus turn-around along the 2500 block of W. Grace St; pursuant to City Code Section 2-428(c). City Code Section 2-428(c) delineates procedures to be used by City Council to alter bus routes.

**BACKGROUND**

GRTC has announced installation of a bus stop at N. Davis Avenue between W. Broad Street and W. Grace Street; and 2.) the installation of a bus turn-around along the 2500 block of W. Grace St. Many residents, property owners, and business owners in the vicinity of the

planned stop and turn-around have voiced opposition to announced plans and have expressed concerns about traffic congestion in area and parking problems if current plans are executed. Council may exercise authority over bus routes in the City pursuant to City Code Section 2-428(c).
