Councilor Parker Agelasto provided an introduction of a proposed amendment to Ord. 2018-110 and stated that the amendment would require directors of departments that provide emergency response during catastrophic events to live within the city limits; however, the amendment also included the allowance for a residency waiver under certain circumstances.

Councilor Ellen Robertson arrived at 4:11 p.m. and was seated.

Councilor Andreas Addison, chief patron of Ord. 2018-110, stated that he has no objections to the proposed amendment since it met the expectations for emergency preparedness.

Councilor Kim Gray expressed concern that the proposed amendment did not include any Council appointees, such as the City Clerk and Council Chief of Staff, as part of the emergency response, noting the necessity of their attendance if an emergency meeting is mandated.

Councilwoman Reva Trammell stated that she cannot support the proposed amendment to Ord. 2018-110.

Councilor Parker Agelasto stated that he was not opposed to adding the City Attorney, City Clerk and Council Chief of Staff positions to the proposed amendment for inclusion to the residency requirement.

President Chris Hilbert expressed his discomfort with Ord. 2018-110 and its proposed amendment.

There were no further comments or discussions concerning Consent and Regular Agenda items reviewed.

Councilor Kim Gray informed Council of increasing traffic mishaps along the Broad Street Bus Rapid Transit Corridor.

President Chris Hilbert requested a briefing on the Greater Richmond Transit Company's bus rapid transit system as well as the new bike lanes along Franklin Street.

Councilor Michael Jones arrived at 4:23 p.m. and was seated.

Richmond Regional Planning District Commission (RRPDC) Strategic Plan

Martha Shickle, RRPDC executive director, provided Council with a presentation regarding RRPDC's background, strategic plan, key findings, mission and values, priorities, portfolio of recent projects and future objectives. A copy of the presentation has been filed.

Tim Davey, RRPDC's Future Ad Hoc Committee chair, was also in attendance.

<u>City Council Expenditure and Reimbursement Guidelines Governing Uses of Council District</u> <u>Funds (Resolution 2015-R18-23)</u>

City Attorney Allen Jackson provided Council with a draft of a proposed amendment to Res. 2015-R18-23, which would no longer require the approval via resolution for reimbursement of Council district funds to councilmembers. A copy of the information has been filed.
