Greetings Members of the Board:

When I purchased 2712 and 2710 East Broad Street I did not realize that they did not have gutters on the front porches. The previous owner rebuilt the front porches and neglected to add gutters. When the porches were inspected the City Inspector neglected to thoroughly check the renovation. Or when the previous owner came before your Committee the gutters were overlooked.

I noticed that my porch columns at the bases were rotting. As well as the porch floor swelling up so much that you can catch your two feet underneath it. I realized that something had to be done immediately especially considering all of the rain we were getting. I had a gutter installed. It is white and very hard to see on the building it blends in perfectly. I saw no other way to preserve the porches. I did this as a desperate measure during all of the rain certainly not to deceive anyone in the Historic District.

The gutters work beautifully and I hope the bases of the columns will dry out. The porch floor has settled back down. My next door neighbor has an identical gutter on his house so I am not setting a precident.
