Project Overview

Location:

- Former Virginia Treatment Center for Children (VTCC) Site Between Clay and Leigh Streets and 10th and 11th Streets
- Groundbreaking occurred June 22, 2018
- Size:
 - AOF ~610,000 Square Feet / 19 Stories
 - Parking Deck 472,684 Square Feet (~ 1,139 Parking Spots)
- Total Project Budget: \$369.2M
- Current Status: Mass Excavation Underway




New Hospitals – Concept Rendering


