#### **SUMMARY & RECOMMENDATION**

**Background**: The Department of Parks and Recreation in collaboration with the Unity Project will install a mural which was designed by students of Martin Luther King, Jr. Middle School during a three week session lead by lead artist Hamilton Glass and James Thornhill.

The Public Art Commission will vote on this project at its September 27, 2018 meeting and provide a recommendation to the Planning Commission.

Staff recommends approval of this project with the following conditions:

- 1. DPRCF staff will secure WISP and observe all conditions set forth by DPW in approval letter.
- 2. Artists will record a list of paint colors for touch up/maintenance if needed with DPRCF.
