PURPOSE: To amend Ord. No. 2018-059, adopted May 14, 2018, which adopted the Capital Improvement Program for fiscal year 2018-2019 and to authorize the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on be-half of the City of Richmond, to accept funds in the total amount of \$3,532,880 from the Virginia Department of Transportation, and to appropriate the revenues to various projects in various categories as set forth on the attachment by \$3,532,880.

REASON: To accept and appropriate \$3,532,880 from VDOT FY19 Revenue Sharing Program funds. These funds were approved by VDOT for the City of Richmond in June 2018.

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RECOMMENDATION: The Department of Public Works recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND: The General Assembly has directed VDOT to establish several initiatives aimed at accelerating road construction and providing funding assistance for the maintenance or improvements to their transportation system. One such initiative is the Revenue Sharing Program; under which the City of Richmond is eligible for matching funds on a 50% Local Funding, 50% State Funding basis. The City has successfully applied for these funds every year since the program's inception.

The City Council authorized and approved the City's participation in the State's FY19/20 Revenue Sharing Program. The list of projects was approved by City Council Resolution 2017-R068 adopted 9/11/17.

The City applied for \$9,900,000 and has been approved for award by VDOT a total of \$5,988,453 (FY19- \$3,532,880; FY20- \$2,455,573) Revenue Sharing Program funds for the projects shown in the attached spreadsheet.

Council action is required to amend the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Capital Improvement Program Budget in order to accept and appropriate the FY19 Revenue Sharing Funds from VDOT. The approved FY20 Revenue Sharing funds will be budgeted during the FY2020-2024 budget cycle. Funding for the City's match is included in the adopted FY19 budget or prior years CIP.

FISCAL IMPACT/COST TO CITY: \$3,532,880. The City's share of the project cost (50%) in the amount of \$3,532,880 for the referenced projects is budgeted in the adopted FY19 budget or prior years CIP.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS: None.

BUDGET AMENDMENT NECESSARY: Yes. This ordinance is to provide amendment to the FY19 CIP budget to appropriate \$3,532,880 to the project account as shown in the attachment.
