THE CITY O	F RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:			
§ 1.	That Chapter 24, Article II, Division 1 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015)			
be and is here	by amended by adding therein a new section 24-34.1 as follows:			
Sec. 24-34.1	Duties of businesses to remove refuse from paved sidewalks and provide refuse receptacles for public use.			
(a)	For purposes of this section:			
	(1) "Business" means a restaurant or an establishment operated by a retailer.			
	(2) "Person" has the meaning set forth in section 1-2.			
	(3) "Refuse" has the meaning set forth in section 23-1.			
	(4) "Restaurant" has the meaning set forth in section 26-872.

- (5) "Retailer" has the meaning set forth in section 26-872.
- (b) It shall be the duty of every person who operates a business on land abutting any paved sidewalk to remove and clear away or cause to be removed or cleared away all refuse from the paved sidewalk abutting such land each day no later than one hour before the commencement of the business' hours of operation for that day.
- (c) It shall be the duty of every person who operates a business on land abutting any paved sidewalk to provide during the business' hours of operation a refuse receptacle for public use located on private property outside the each entrance and exit to the business that is open to the public and to empty that refuse receptacle whenever such refuse receptacle is full but at least once daily.
- (d) Any person violating subsections (b) or (c) shall be guilty of a Class 4 misdemeanor. Each day on which a person fails to perform a duty required by subsections (b) or (c) shall constitute a separate violation.
 - § 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.

BACKGROUND
