THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That section 4-248 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015), as amended, be and is hereby **amended** and reordained as follows:

Sec. 4-248. Disposition of deceased companion animal.

The owner of any dead companion animal shall forthwith cremate, bury or otherwise sanitarily dispose of the companion animal, or such owner shall call the City animal shelter and have the companion animal picked up and properly disposed of. When requested by the owner, the City animal shelter will pick up and dispose of a dead companion animal for a fee as set forth

in Appendix A to this Code to defray the cost of providing such service. [However, no charge will be made for the pickup and disposal of a dead companion animal euthanized by the Richmond Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals.] Upon failure, refusal or neglect to do so, after notice to the owner, a judge of the General District Court, Criminal Division, shall order the dead companion animal to be disposed of by the Director and shall require the owner to pay the City the cost for this service.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
