The Commission shall consist of **two** (2) **non-voting members** and **nine** (9) **voting members**. The two (2) non-voting members shall be the Director of Public Works and the Director of Community Development, or their designee. Of the nine (9) voting members, the Mayor shall appoint three (3) members and the City Council shall appoint six (6) members. One member shall be a certified arborist, and one member shall be a registered certified landscape architect.

Except for the certified arborist, all voting members shall be residents of the city. No voting member shall be an officer or employee of the City and no member shall hold any contract with the City, or subcontract thereof, to provide goods or services relating to City-owned trees.


