Two members shall be members of the council appointed to serve terms coincident with their terms as members of the city council, three members, at least one of whom shall be a certified public accountant, shall be appointed from the business community of the city and two members, of which either shall be a lawyer or shall have experience in the financial services industry.Councilmembers appointed to the audit committee shall succeed themselves no more than two times, and citizen members shall not be allowed to succeed themselves more than two times. All appointments of citizen members shall be for terms of three years.

All members of the Commission shall be residents of the city of Richmond and shall be broadly representative of the community with respect to race, color, religion, sex, pregnancy, childbirth or related medical conditions, national origin, age, marital status, disability, sexual orientation, transgender status, or gender identity.
