- § 1. That stop signs shall be erected on the northwest and southeast corners at the intersection of Juniper Street and 3rd Avenue and a curb ramp shall be installed on the northeast corner at the intersection of Juniper Street and 3rd Avenue.
- § 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption or such other date as may be fixed by traffic order of the Director of Public Works if, prior to adoption, the two stop signs have been erected and the curb ramp installed at the aforesaid intersection.
