MOTIONS TO AMEND

- 1. To amend Ord. No. 2018-307, which authorizes the special use of the property known as 1204 North 30th Street for the purpose of up to four two-family attached dwellings, to include revised plans.
- 2. To amend Ord. No. 2018-308, which authorizes the special use of the property known as 1301 North 30th Street for the purpose of a building with commercial uses on the first floor and up to two dwelling units, to impose additional conditions on such use.
- 3. To amend Res. No. 2018-R104, which expresses the Council's support for the use of construction contractors who work with local workforce development programs that work to enable residents of economically challenged minority communities to become employed, especially in construction-related fields, to instead express such support for the use of such contractors generally.

To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer to accept funds in the amount of \$50,000.00 from the Supreme Court of Virginia; to amend the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Special Fund Budget by creating a new special fund for the Department of Justice Services called the Richmond General District Court Behavioral Health Docket Special Fund; and to appropriate the grant funds received to the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Special Fund Budget by increasing estimated revenues and the amount appropriated to the Department of Justice Services' Richmond General District Court Behavioral Health Docket Special Fund by \$50,000.00 for the purpose of providing additional services to participants of the General District Court of the City of Richmond's mental health docket program. {No Committee Rule VI(B)(3)(c)}

To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer to accept funds in the amount of \$860,451.00 from Central Virginia Investments/Rocketts Landing, LLC; to amend the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Capital Budget by establishing a new project in the City Facility Maintenance & Improvements category called the "Hopkins Road Transfer Station Repairs" project; and to appropriate the funds received to the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Capital Budget by increasing revenues and the amount appropriated to the new Department of Public Works' Hopkins Road Transfer Station Repairs project by \$860,451.00 for the purpose of making structural and architectural repairs to the Hopkins Road Transfer Station. {Planning Commission February 4, 2019}
