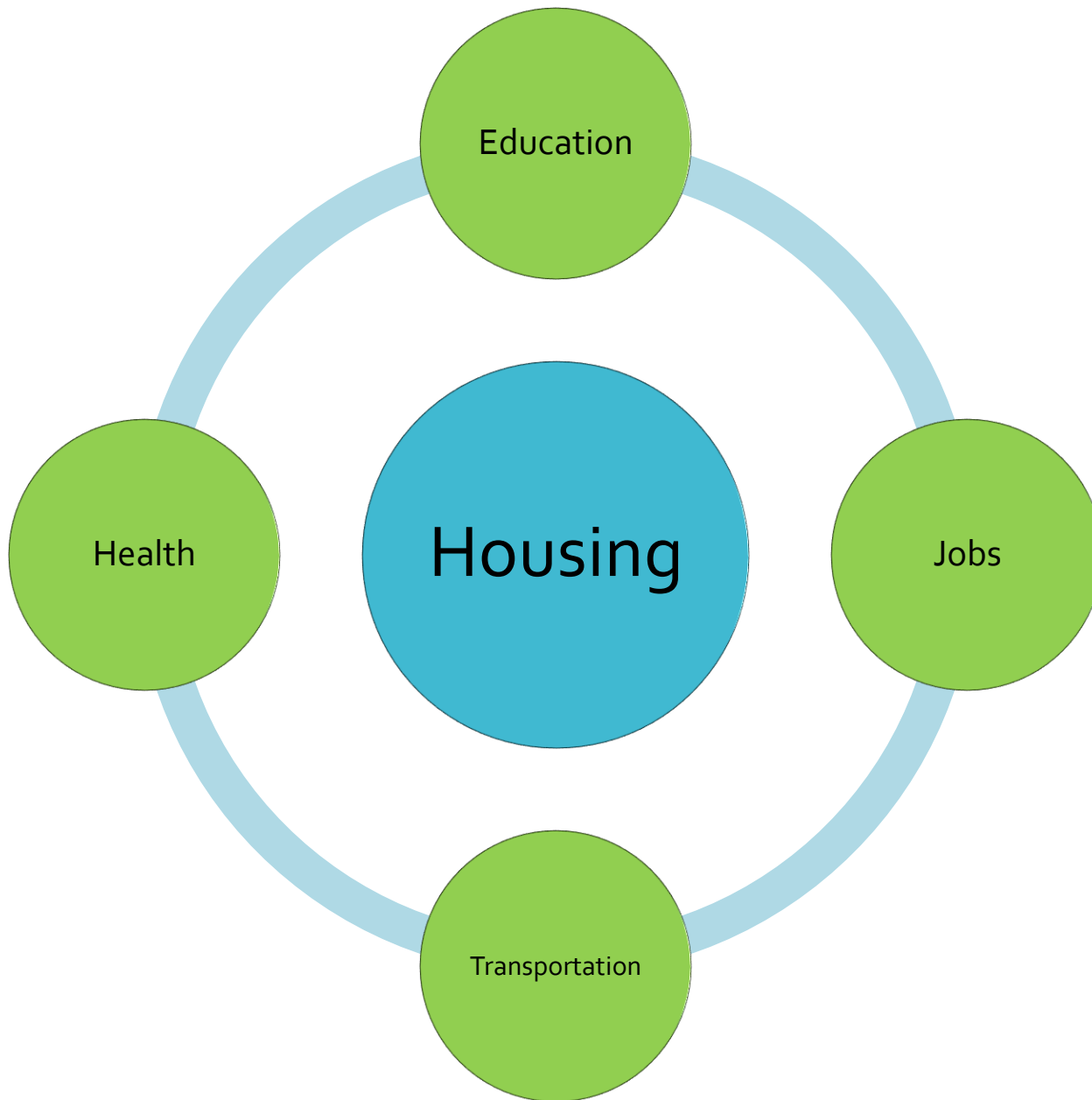

Timeline

Phase One: October 2018 – December 2019

- HD Advisors as Lead Consultants

Phase Two: April 2019 – June 2022

- PHA hires Director of Implementation
- Coordinate with jurisdictions
- Implement strategies
- Measure outcomes
