ORD. 2018-254

To amend Ord. Lynne Lancaster, interim deputy director – Department of Public Works, introduced ORD. 2019-105 and responded to questions regarding operation of Main Street Station.

Member Parker Agelasto inquired about the transfer of services to the Department of Public Works, the appropriation of funds for the management of Main Street Station, and contractual obligations for services and special events.

There were no further comments or discussions and Vice Chair Larson moved to forward ORD. 2019-105 to Council with the recommendation to approve, which was seconded and approved: Ayes 2, Larson and Jones. Abstentions 1, Agelasto.

ORD. 2019-106

To amend Ord. No. 2018-057, adopted May 14, 2018, which adopted the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 General Fund Budget and made appropriations pursuant thereto, by increasing anticipated revenues from personal property taxes and the amount appropriated to the Office of Animal Care and Control's Animal Control program by \$180,000.00 for the purpose of funding costs for mandated services for animal cruelty cases including forensic testing, veterinary surgeries, and other operational expenses. **Patron:** Mayor Stoney

Christie Peters, director – Richmond Animal Care and Control, introduced ORD. 2019-106 and responded to questions relative to an increase in operation; she also stated that community awareness was a key component in reducing illegal dog fighting in the city.

There were no further comments or discussions and **Member Agelasto moved to forward** ORD. 2019-106 to Council with the recommendation to approve, which was seconded and unanimously approved.

To approve the Mayor's appointment of Aubrey Woolworth Fountain, III, as a member of the Board of Directors of the Richmond Metropolitan Transportation Authority for a term commencing on the adoption of this resolution and expiring four years thereafter, succeeding Dr. Rodney D. Waller. **Patron:** Mayor Stoney

Tameka Jefferson, constituent services manager – Mayor's Office, introduced RES. 2019-R015. There were no further comments or discussions and Vice Chair Larson moved to forward RES. 2019-R015 to Council with the recommendation to approve, which was seconded and unanimously approved.
