### **Issuance of Business Licenses**

- Business License Renewal Deadline: March 1<sup>st</sup>
- Business Personal Property Return due: March 1<sup>st</sup>
- BPP Return required for Business License issuance
- In 2019: Business Licenses issued on March 27th
- In prior years: Business Licenses issued mid-April at the earliest



### **Limitation on Business Licenses**

- Ordinance 2013-83-52 amended City Code concerning Business License requirements
- No business license shall be issued until ... all delinquent business license, real estate, personal property, meals, transient occupancy, severance and admissions taxes owed by the business to the City have been paid



# Business, Professional and Occupational License (BPOL) Taxes

- As of 6/30/19, 2,732 businesses owed a combined \$4,317,496 in BPOL taxes
- Some businesses are on payment plans with the City
- Statutory Assessments are made when nonresponsive businesses have unfiled periods
- Tax Enforcement staff routinely visit businesses that are delinquent, regularly go to Court
