WHEREAS, section 2-428 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015), as amended, requires an appropriate study by the Department of Public Works prior to the adoption of an ordinance regulating motor vehicle traffic within the City; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance has been properly referred to the Department of Public Works, and more than 60 days have elapsed since such referral;


THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption or such other date as may be fixed by traffic order of the Director of Public Works if, prior to adoption, the all-way stop signs have been erected at the aforesaid intersection.

ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY

The patron requests an ordinance to require the installation of a four-way stop sign at the intersection of 14th and Perry St. in Richmond, VA.

The purpose of the ordinance includes the following:

- Regulate all northbound and southbound traffic travelling on 14th Street at Perry Street.
- Regulate all eastbound and westbound traffic travelling on Perry Street at 14th Street.

BACKGROUND

Impetus for the Request:

1. Weekend gatherings:
 - Sundays can draw up to 1300-1400 people for mass services
 - Saturdays can draw up to 300 people
 - There are over 30 special mass services taking place at night during the week and include 600-800 people
2. Pedestrian Safety:
 - Churches and other organizations have filed numerous reports of accidents and complaints of near missies at this intersection.

Other notes to consider:

- The Ordinance will take effect immediately upon adoption.
- A minimal fiscal impact will include the installation of signage at these locations.
