PURPOSE: To authorize the City Administration by way of the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) to accept funds from SMG Richmond in the amount of \$72,385.09 and appropriate to a new Special Fund Revenue (0401-03612-44818) titled "17th Street Farmers Market" in Fiscal Year 2019 within the Department of Economic Development.

REASON: SMG previously operated an ice rink on behalf of the City on Broad Street. In November of 2018, the ice rink was relocated to the 17th Street Farmers and was to be managed under the City's contract with EnRichmond Foundation. Rink Management, LLC was contracted by the En-Richmond Foundation to set-up, manage, rent skates, program activities, and breakdown the rink for a specified time period at a cost of \$115,000, plus a \$2400.00 retainage fee. In addition, the Enrichmond Foundation incurred the cost of building the sand-base for the ice rink at the 17th Street Farmers Market at a cost of an additional \$12,000. Upon the completion of the project the sand was repurposed as a volley-ball court to a venue owned by the City's Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities.

The stated amount to be accepted by the City is unused income generated from previous skate rentals under SMG's operation of the ice rink.

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RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that these funds be accepted and appropriated to a new Special Fund within the Department of Economic Development for 17th Street Farmers Market for Fiscal Year 2019. Once appropriated to the Special Fund, these funds will be used to pay expenses incurred for the RVA ice rink and related 17th Street Farmers Market improvements in FY 19.

BACKGROUND: SMG Richmond had maintained funds provided to them by City Administration since FY 16 for the operation of the Ice Rink on Broad Street. Upon the transfer for the operation of the ice rink from SMG to EnRichmond, SMG management returned the unused portion of skate rental revenues from the Ice Rink to the City. The intended use of this returned revenue is to apply to the cost of the ice rink and other expenses incurred at the 17th Street Market.

SOURCE: The source of funding was from SMG Richmond's unused program income and skate rentals for the continuation of the Ice Rink located at 6th and Broad Street.
