ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY

The patron requests a resolution to request a joint meeting with the Mayor and City Council to establish collectively city priorities and to discuss concerns in each district.

BACKGROUND

Why this resolution is needed:

- Several members of the Richmond City Council have expressed a desire to develop city-wide (1) strategic, (2) operational and (3) fiscal priorities that will reflect and address the needs of all districts;
- In accordance with Res. 2018-R019, (which requests the CAO to develop a policy and methodology for performance-based budgeting), having a consensus agreement on the most critical priorities will allow the City to develop, analyze and evaluate performance measures that reflect those critical priorities:
- In accordance with Ord. 2018-030, (which requires preparation of strategic actions for each City department), having a consensus agreement on the most critical priorities will allow the City to align department operational plans that reflect the City's most critical priorities;
- Having a joint meeting between the Mayor and City Council to collectively and collaboratively develop the City's priorities and have open discussion on challenges in districts which can be used for the development of next year's budget;
- The patron believes that having a joint meeting with the Mayor and City Council, to work in conjunction with one another, is a critical first step for establishing the priorities of the City.

It is further requested that the Office of the Council Chief of Staff and the Department of Budget and Strategic Planning work together to coordinate this effort..
