

City of Richmond Full Time Permanent Positions Sorted by Funded vs Filled Variance As of 1st Quarter FY 2020









 Quarter 2020 and FY2019











Separated Employees By Department As of 1st Quarter FY20 (total 57)




Number of Separations By Job Classification (dept listed if 3 or more were in that same dept with the same job class)



Separated Employees By Department As of 1st Quarter FY20 (total 57), FY19 (total 350) and FY18 (total 305)






