The Commission shall consist of **nine (9) members**. The Council shall appoint seven (7) of the members, one of whom must have expertise in urban forestry. The Mayor shall appoint two (2) members, one of whom shall be a city employee in the Department of Public Works or the designee thereof.

Of the remaining members, one member shall be selected from each of the following fields:

- (1) Sustainability.
- (2) Green building practices.
- (3) Energy efficiency.
- (4) Environmental protection.

At least **four** of the **Council appointees shall reside in the city or have their principal place of employment in the city** in accordance with section 2-756 of this Code. The **remaining** Council **appointees and the Mayor's appointee** other than the Director of Public Works or the designee thereof **shall not** be subject to any requirement that they maintain a residence or a principal place of employment in the city. All other aspects of the commission and its membership not addressed in this division shall be governed by Chapter 2, Article V, Division 1 of the City Code.


