FEE AT 100 NORTH 17TH STREET PARKING FACILITY

ORD. OR RES. No.

PURPOSE: To amend Appendix A Section 12-120 (a)(20) of the City Code, to authorize the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO), on behalf of the City of Richmond, to establish a monthly evening rate designed for employees of various businesses in the Shockoe Bottom Commercial District.

REASON: To create a monthly evening rate for employees of various businesses in Shockoe Bottom at the parking facility located at 100 North 17th Street.

RECOMMENDATION: Approval is recommended by the City Administration.

BACKGROUND:

Due to development in the Shockoe Bottom Commercial District, employees and employers are struggling to find monthly evening parking. The monthly rates at the various parking facilities are cost prohibitive for the employees that work limited hours at the various restaurants in the Bottom.

The Shockoe Bottom Neighborhood/Business Association met with DPW to establish a monthly parking fee designed for employees of various businesses in the Bottom. After discussion, DPW

and the Association came to a consensus of \$40 per month from 4 pm to 6 am, 7 days a week in the 100 N. 17th Street parking facility only.

An application process will be developed which will include proof of employment at a Shockoe Bottom business and the signature of the employer verifying employment. The monthly evening hours will be from 4 pm to 6 am.
