ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY

The Patron requests that the Department of Planning complete a redevelopment study of Commerce Road and Surrounding Area, bounded by the 9th street bridge and the 1-95 exchange along Commerce Road and to include the Port. The study should be similar in design and requirements as the Greater Scott's Addition Redevelopment Study currently being completed.

BACKGROUND

Summary:

- Currently, the City is working with a consultant on a redevelopment study of Greater Scott's Addition.
- Previously, the City completed the Pulse Corridor Plan. As a follow up to the Pulse Corridor Plan, the Department of Planning and Development is working with the Shockoe Alliance to create a Small Area Plan for the Shockoe Area.
- The Patron believes that the Commerce Road and Surrounding Area would benefit from similar planning and investment as Scott's Addition. Both areas are similar in that they were previously industrial areas that are now mixed used, and are both seeing growth with small businesses and housing moving into the area.
