

To participate in the City Council Special meeting on Monday, August 3, 2020, at 5:00 p.m., you have the following options:

**1. Listen to the meeting by phone but not participate.**

You may listen to the meeting audio only from your phone by dialing \*67-804-316-9457 and when prompted, enter conference ID 111490100#.

**2. Watch to the meeting online by computer, tablet or smartphone but not participate.**

This meeting will be livestreamed at the following web address: <https://richmondva.legistar.com/Calendar.aspx>. To access the livestream, find and click the link that reads, "In Progress" in the farthest right hand column entitled, "Video".

**3. Provide public comment regarding proposed legislation on the agenda prior to the meeting.**

Citizens are encouraged to provide their comments in writing to [CityClerksOffice@richmondgov.com](mailto:CityClerksOffice@richmondgov.com) in lieu of speaking in-person or through electronic communication means.

When submitting your comments by email, be sure to include in your email (i) your full legal name, (ii) any organizations you represent, and (iii) any economic or professional relationships that would be affected by the adoption of the legislation on which you are commenting.

All written comments received via email prior to **10:00 a.m., on Monday, August 3, 2020**, will be provided to all members of Council prior to the beginning of the meeting and will be included in the record of the meeting.

**4. Provide in-person public comment regarding legislation considered by Council, in the Council Chamber on the Second Floor of City Hall, located at 900 East Broad Street, Richmond, Virginia.**

**5. Provide virtual public comment regarding legislation considered by Council, during the live meeting via Microsoft Teams.**

To request to speak virtually via Microsoft Teams during any of the meeting's public hearings, you must sign up prior to the meeting by either:

1. Calling the City Clerk's office at 646-7955 and selecting option 3. If staff is not available to take your call, please leave a voicemail with your request to speak, your name, and your contact number, and the City Clerk's staff will call you to sign you up; or
2. Sending an email to [CityClerksOffice@richmondgov.com](mailto:CityClerksOffice@richmondgov.com) with your request to speak along with your name.

Public speakers must make contact with the City Clerk's office no later than **Monday, August 3, at 10:00 a.m.**, to participate virtually during the meeting. Participation guidelines and instructions will be provided to individuals before the meeting.

Those who have signed up to speak virtually concerning a specific item of legislation before Council, will be called upon at the appropriate time, and the applicable time limits will be enforced.
