§ 1. That section 9-2 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015) be and is hereby **amended** and reordained as follows:

Sec. 9-2. Central absentee voter election district.



ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY

Amend City Code §9-2 which designates the location for the central absentee voter election district for the purpose of relocating the central absentee voter election district to the new location for the Main Office of the General Registrar.

BACKGROUND

The Central Absentee Voter election district (CAP) is the precinct that processes all absentee ballots on election day. The physical location for this precinct is designated by §9-2 of the City Code as being the Fifth Floor Conference Room in City Hall located 900 East Broad Street.

This O&R is to amend City Code §9-2 which designates the location for the central absentee voter election district for the purpose of relocating the central absentee voter election district to the new location at 2134 West Laburnum Avenue. This will serve as the new location for the Main Office of the General Registrar,

For the General Election, November 3, 2020, the Office of the General Registrar will be in its new location. The CAP operations will also be at that same location. The proposed new

location is accessible for persons with disabilities.

Notice of this relocation will be included in the notice which must be mailed to all voters to announce the relocation of the Main Office of the General Registrar itself. As such, this change is not expected to have any fiscal impact. It is expected that this notice will be mailed to all voters at the end of August.

The requested introduction date is July 27, 2020.

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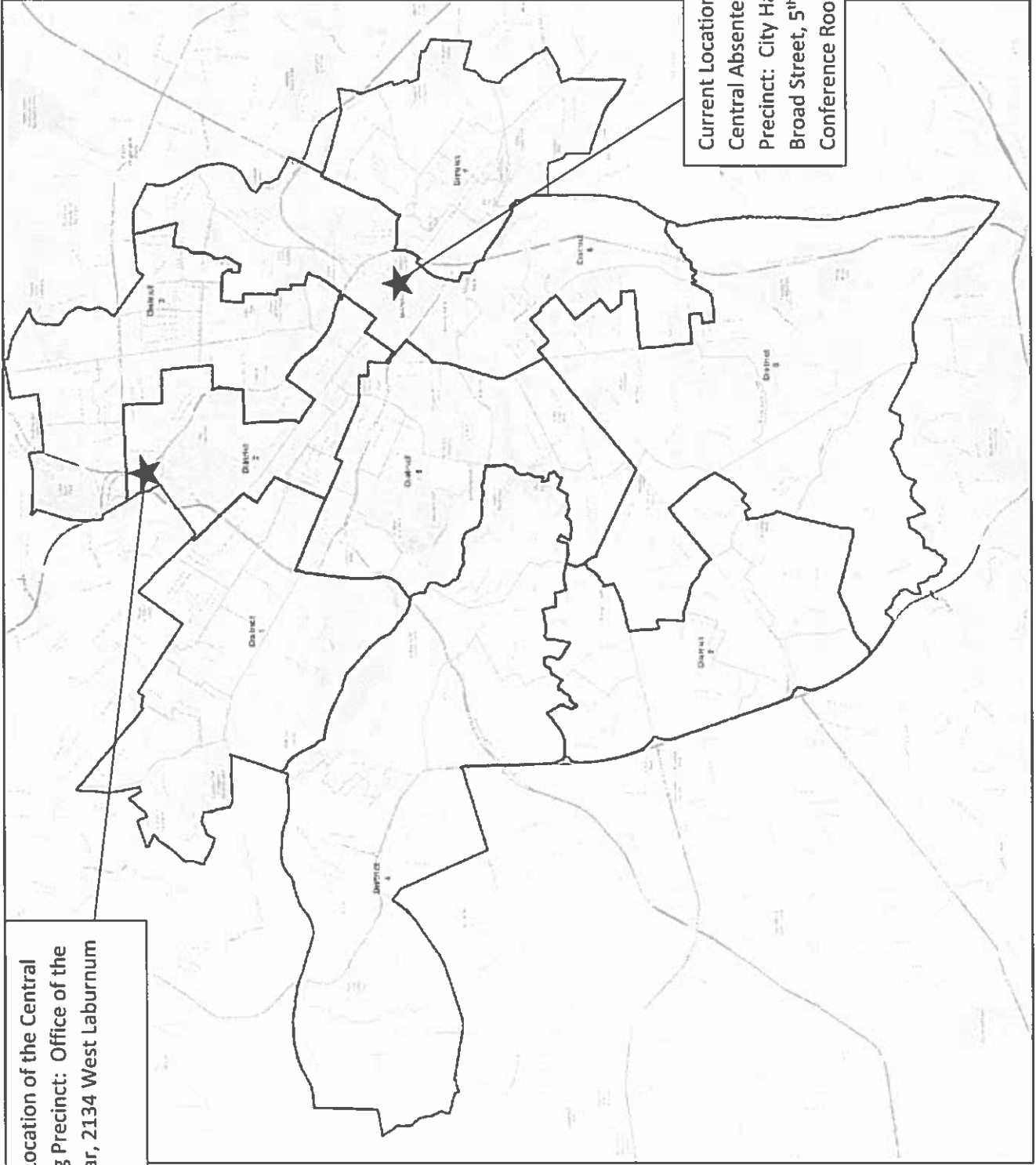
