In November of 2019 the Bellevue Civic Association approved a beautification project for the Northwest corner of Bellevue and Fauquier Avenues. The corner is part of the city of Richmond's Right-of-Way and is currently an unimproved space of weeds, scrub growth, and a recently planted elm tree.

The project involves clearing the space from the tip of the corner back to the elm tree. Professional contractor will lay concrete pavers parallel to the Bellevue sidewalk and the Fauquier curb. A curved 2' sitting wall will run between the two roads. The cost of this project and its maintenance will be borne by the BCA.

I am in favor of this neighborhood beautification project.
