PURPOSE: To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer, on behalf of the City of Richmond, to execute a quitclaim deed between the CAPITAL REGION AIRPORT COMMISSION, a Political subdivision organized under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, and the City of Richmond, Virginia. The quitclaim deed releases a portion of a utility easement that was previously granted to the, but is unused by City.

REASON: The CAPITAL REGION AIRPORT COMMISSION now requests that the portion of the easement, as shown on a plat titled "Plat Showing Quitclaim of a Sanitary Sewer Easement on the Land of Capital Region Airport Commission" be vacated by the City to allow for development on the Capital Region Airport Commission's property. DEED OF QUITCLAIM OF UTILITY EASEMENT PORTION

THIS DEED OF QUITCLAIM OF UTILITY EASEMENT PORTION (this "Deed") is made this ____ day of ______, 2020, by and between the CITY OF RICHMOND, a municipal corporation organized under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, to be indexed as grantor (the "GRANTOR"), and CAPITAL REGION AIRPORT COMMISSION, a political subdivision organized under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, to be indexed as grantee (the "GRANTEE") (collectively, the "Parties").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, GRANTEE is the owner of certain real property located in the County of Henrico, Virginia, designated as GPIN 822-716-2325 and being a portion of the same real estate conveyed to GRANTEE by deed recorded in the Clerk's Office of the Circuit Court of the County of Henrico (the "Clerk's Office") at Deed Book 1823, Page 1660 (the "Property");

WHEREAS, by Decd of Easement dated June 29, 1971 and recorded on July 28, 1971 in the Clerk's Office at Deed Book 1472, Page 338, and by Deed of Easement dated November 4, 1971 and recorded November 17, 1971 in the Clerk's Office at Deed Book 1486, Page 4 (collectively, the "Easement Deeds"), GRANTOR accepted a permanent utility easement (the "Easement") within the area described in the Easement Deeds (the "Easement Area"); and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire that GRANTOR vacate, convey, remise, release, and forever quitclaim to GRANTEE a portion of the Easement Area, the location of which portion is hatched and labeled as "Portion of Ex. 16' Sanitary Sewer Easement (Hereby Quitclaimed)" on that certain plat entitled Plat Showing Quitclaim of a Sanitary Sewer Easement on the Land of Capital Region Airport Commission (Deed Book 1823 Page 1660), prepared by christopher consultants, ltd., dated January 27, 2020, revised June 12, 2020, and marked as "Attachment A," attached hereto and made a part hereof (the "Portion"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of Ordinance No. 20_______, adopted by the Richmond City Council on _______, 20____, and attached hereto as "Attachment B" without its attachments which are duplicative of this Deed and the Attachments hereto, GRANTOR has agreed to vacate, convey, remise, release, and forever quitclaim to GRANTEE the Portion, as more particularly set forth in this Deed.

- Each individual executing this Deed represents that he or she is duly authorized to bind GRANTOR or GRANTEE, as the case may be, to the terms and provisions of this Deed.


