THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That section 27-283 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015), as amended, be and is hereby amended and reordained as follows:

Sec. 27-283. Same—Performance measurements.

(a) The Director of Public Works shall conduct a study annually to determine if the program has successfully achieved the goals set forth in Section 27-281 and submit a report of the results of such study to the City Council by no later than [March] September 1 of each year. The report shall include:

(1) Details concerning expenditures from the Special Parking Districts SpecialFund;

(2) The sufficiency of the fund to achieve the goals set forth in Section 27-281 and for the services and activities for which monies from the Special Parking Districts Special Fund may be expended in accordance with Section 27-282;

- (3) The results of the surveys conducted in accordance with Section 27-284; and
- (4) Any recommendations for improvement of the program.

(b) The Director of Public Works shall monitor the use of the Special Parking Districts Special Fund to ensure that there is sufficient funding for the permit process established pursuant to Sections 27-279 and 27-280 for residential restricted parking districts and for the services and activities for which the Special Parking Districts Special Fund may be expended and to ensure that the proceeds from the Special Parking Districts Special Fund are properly allocated in accordance with this Code and other applicable law. In addition, the Director of Public Works shall consider the results of the surveys conducted in accordance with Section 27-284.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.

PURPOSE: To amend Ordinance No.2011-78-62 Sec. 102-305 (a) adopted April 25, 2011 to change the due date for submission of the annual study to September 1 of each year instead of March 1 of each year.

REASON: The March 1st report submission does not reflec. a complete reporting of the fiscal year revenue and expenditures. A September 1st submission will enable DPW to provide a report of expenditures and revenue for the entire fiscal year.

RECOMMENDATION: The Administration recommends approval.

BACKGROUND: On May 24, 2010, City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2010-73-86 which diverts \$30 of each \$50 fine collected to the newly established special fund entitled "Special Parking District" to a maximum of \$363,000. The fines established for committing infractions in the restricted parking districts are aimed at deterring negative behaviors. The funds are to be used to cover the cost of enchantments that will provide and maintain environments that are cleaner and safer to student, residents and visitors.

By letter the Director of Finance designated the Department of Public Works (DPW) to oversee the Special Parking Districts Program. DPW has been operating the program since its inception. DPW design he program and manages operations.
