Title 15.2, Subtitle II, Chapter 15, Article 8 (§§ 15.2-1544—15.2-1549) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, provides that the governing body of a city, county, or town may establish a trust for the purpose of accumulating and investing assets to fund Other Post-Employment Benefits.

In accordance with section 15.2-1547 of the Code of Virginia, this board shall consist of at least three members who shall include the chief financial officer as a citizen member, treasurer of the City of Richmond, and at least one other additional person who shall be a citizen of the Commonwealth with proven integrity, business ability, and demonstrated experience in cash management and investments.

The Board of Trustees, in addition to all powers and authorities under common law or statutory authority, including Article 8, Chapter 15, Subtitle II of Title 15.2 of the Virginia Code(§§ 15.2-1544 et seq.), shall have and in its sole and absolute discretion may exercise from time to time and at any time, either through its own actions, delegation to the Administrator, or through a Custodian selected by the Board of Trustees, the administrative powers and authority with respect to the Trust Fund as outlined in Sections 102 and 103 of the Trust Agreement attached to Ordinance No. 2018-196, adopted July 23, 2018.

The advisory board shall be composed of nine members appointed by the Council. Of the nine members, five members shall be representatives of a minority business enterprise, two members shall be representatives of lenders or businesses other than a minority business enterprise, one member shall be a Section 3 contractor representative and one member shall be either an at-large resident of the city or a member of the Council.

The Council shall nominate:

- Three members who shall be representatives of a minority business enterprise,
- One member who shall be a representative of lenders or businesses other than a minority business enterprise, and
- One member who shall be either an at-large resident of the city or a member of the Council.

The Mayor shall nominate:

- Two members who shall be representatives of a minority business enterprise,
- One member who shall be a representative of lenders or businesses other than a minority business enterprise, and
- One member who shall be a Section 3 contractor representative.

The Board may elect from its membership a chairman and other officers it deems necessary in accordance with its rules of procedure or bylaws.
