The commission shall be composed of 15 members appointed by City Council. Eight (8) members shall be nominated by council and seven (7) members nominated by the mayor.

The members of the commission, at least eight of whom shall be residents of the city, shall be representatives from any combination of the following categories, provided that no member shall be an employee of any correctional facility:

- 1. Resident of a community within the city where correctional resident-based services, establishments providing alternatives to incarceration or correctional facilities are located
- 2. At-large resident of the city
- 3. Richmond Public Schools
- 4. Workforce development agency
- 5. Small minority business development organization
- 6. Technical educational institution
- 7. Higher educational institution
- 8. Law enforcement
- 9. State or local department of social services
- 10. Administrator of a community-based corrections program
- 11. Faith-based community organization
- 12. Business community
- 13. Council member representing the district in which the Justice Center is located

Chief Administrative Officer or his designee.







The Task Force shall consist of nine residents of the city of Richmond appointed by the Council. All appointments shall be otherwise governed by sections 2-755 and 2-756 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015), as amended.

The membership of the Task Force should possess a broad range of experience with expertise in policy development, legal, racial, and social justice advocacy, criminal justice education, or human resources. Of the nine members,

- (i) at least one member shall be a youth age 18 or younger,
- (ii) at least one member shall be a resident of public housing, and
- (iii) at least one member shall be a person with a disability.

The Task Force shall submit to the Council a status report on the progress towards the completion of the Task Force's duties set forth in Ordinance No. 2020-155 by no later than January 4, 2021. The Task Force shall submit to the Council a final written report, containing the Task Force's reviews and recommendations concerning the creation of a Civilian Review Board, including a proposed annual budget for any Civilian Review Board that the Task Force may recommend, by no later than March 1, 2021.

Section 36-11 of the Code of Virginia (1950) authorizes the Council to provide for not more than nine or less than five commissioners of the Authority. By Resolution No. 99-R46-80, adopted March 22, 1999, the Council increased the number of commissioners from five to seven as authorized by section 36-11 of the Code of Virginia (1950). Resolution No. 2010-R140-162, adopted October 25, 2010, increased the number of commissioners from seven to nine with the addition of a Council-appointed seat and an additional tenant representative seat.

Pursuant to section 36-11 of the Code of Virginia (1950), no commissioner of the Authority may be an officer or employee of the City. By Resolution No. 2003-R230-2004-R18, adopted January 12, 2004, the Council established a procedure to be followed for appointing one member living in public or assisted housing to serve on the Authority's Board of Commissioners as required by the regulations of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development. This resolution was further amended by Resolution No. 2010-R141-173, adopted November 8, 2010, which revised the process of appointing the tenant representatives to the board.






