WHEREAS, it is the consensus of the Council that it would be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Richmond and especially the citizens who reside near the aforesaid intersections to erect all-way stop signs at said intersections; and

WHEREAS, section 2-428 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015), as amended, requires an appropriate study by the Department of Public Works prior to the adoption of an ordinance regulating motor vehicle traffic within the City; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance has been properly referred to the Department of Public Works, and more than 60 days have elapsed since such referral;

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

- § 1. That all-way stop signs shall be erected at the intersections of Bainbridge Street and West 10th Street; Bainbridge Street and West 12th Street; Bainbridge Street and West 14th Street; Porter Street and West 12th Street; Porter Street and West 14th Street; Perry Street and West 10th Street; Perry Street and West 12th Street; McDonough Street and West 10th Street; McDonough Street and West 14th Street; McDonough Street and West 14th Street.
- § 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption or such other date as may be fixed by traffic order of the Director of Public Works if, prior to adoption, the all-way stop signs have been erected at the aforesaid intersections.

ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY

The Patron requests an ordinance to require installation of four way stop signs with painted stop bars at the following eleven intersections located in the Manchester neighborhood:

- Bainbridge and 10th, 12th, and 14th
- Porter and 10th, 12th, and 14th
- Perry and 10th, and 12th
- McDonough and 10th, 12th, and 14th

BACKGROUND

Summary:

- The Patron believes that speeding in this area endangers pedestrians and vehicular traffic.
- The community within this neighborhood has requested the installation of these 4 way stop signs and pointed bars as a means to increase safety for children and pedestrians.

- Manchester is one of the City's fastest growing neighborhoods. The increase of residents in the neighborhood has led to an increase in commuters, pedestrians, and families with children playing outside.
- A traffic calming study has been recommended by DPW for this area within Manchester.
