# Total Fire Responses 1st Quarter

#### Total Responses 7392

- ▶ 4022 were EMS Calls for Service
- 3370 were Fire and other Calls for Service
  - Working Fires
  - Rescues, Alarms, Accidents etc



#### Second-Alarm & Third-Alarm Fires







- Multi-alarm fires are requested for a variety of reasons including more resources, high-rise residential settings, etc.
- So far in 2021, we've had five multi-alarm fires → two second-alarm fires described as near-miss scenarios.
  - ▶ January 23, 2021 1025 West Grace Street (Dominion Place Apartments)
  - February 23, 2021 1715 Bellevue Avenue (Imperial Plaza Apartments)
  - ▶ 14 events where mutual aid was provided by outside organizations to RFD.





# Fatal Fires (2021)



- 1. January 24, 2021 3112 Baronet Drive
  - 57-year-old male victim
  - Had smoke alarms
  - Cause of fire: electrical
- 2. March 10, 2021 609 West 34th Street
  - 69-year-old female victim
  - No smoke alarms
  - Heavily cluttered conditions
  - Cause of fire: electrical
- 3. March 16, 2021 2219 Royall Avenue
  - 57-year-old male victim
  - No smoke alarms, no running water
  - Heavily cluttered conditions
  - Cause of fire: discarded smoking materials

## Emergency Response Turnout Time

#### Fire - Target is 90 seconds

▶ 102 seconds is the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile

#### EMS – Target is 60 seconds

▶ 94 seconds is the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile



## First Engine Arrive on Scene

# Target is 240 seconds with 4 members


▶ 90<sup>th</sup> percentile time between dispatch and on scene is 457.7 seconds



## Response RFD EMT

# Target is arrival in 6 minutes or less

60.54% of the time RFD responded to an EMS related call in 360 seconds or less




## Fire Investigations
