### Text Amendment

Any surplus revenues above the project FY 2022 business, professional, and occupational license tax revenues shall be dedicated to the project.

Any savings identified by the Office of the City Auditor as a result of the funded fiscal review must be dedicated to the project.

With the exception of the levy imposed pursuant to § 36-137, any fees levied pursuant to this subsection (B. New City of Richmond hires shall be placed in the Virginia Retirement System effective July 1, 2022. Eligible existing employees shall be placed in the Virginia Retirement System effective July 1, 2022.

Make the Office of Sustainability an independent office, separate from the Department of Public Works.

Reservation of fund balance of \$847,000 to be used for permanent supportive housing.

Support recommendations for the Southside Revitalization Task Force Plan through rezoning.

Increase funding for specialty dockets (Mental Health & Drug Dockets) to reduce recidivism. Funding should evaluate the impact of the program.

Request the Planning Department review staffing to have entry level inspectors handle the vegetation ordinances.

Create a Commission to review the City Charter.

A text amendment requiring that the adoption of the budget requires a collaborative SOP to include work session: Make the Office of Sustainability an independent office, separate from the Department of Public Works.

Adopt an ordinance to require that the Department of Human Resources report on the labor market movement.

Adopt an ordinance to require that the Pay & Classification minimum / midpoint / maximum ranges and employment levels be reported.

Adopt an ordinance to require that the Capital Improvement Plan FY23 and subsequent budgets shall include project information.

Adopt an ordinance to require that the General Fund Operating Budget include, for each program, or budget item.
