Southside Regional Park & Community Center: from \$175K to \$200K

Community Gardens: from \$75K to \$100K Shockoe Bottom: from TBD to \$500K

Historic Fulton Memorial Park from \$50K to \$75K

Monument Avenue: from \$1M to TBD Westover Hills: from \$25K to \$50K Hillside Court: from \$15K to \$50K
