Previous Reviews	The application to install an electronic sign was heard by CAR in February 2021 and was denied. In May 2021, staff Administratively Approved the construction of a standalone brick and concrete monument sign with a non-illuminated marquee display board.	
Staff Recommendations	The applicant work with staff – with final approval from the Chair and Vice Chair – to determine a lighting plan for the existing sign that can be administratively approved.	

## **Staff Analysis**

Guideline Reference	Reference Text	Analysis
General Signage Guidelines, pg. 75	8. Signs should not use animation or flashing or moving lights.	The applicant proposes to convert the panel portion of the freestanding sign to an LED display. Since LED signs are not permitted in City Old and Historic Districts, staff recommends denial of the application.
	9. LED and plasma display signs will not be approved for use in City Old and Historic Districts.	

Guidelines for Administrative Approval of Light Fixtures, Items Delegated for Staff Review

The installation of conduit, motion detection fixtures, security lights, sconces, freestanding lights minimally visible from the public right-of-way.

If the applicant is interested in additional illumination for the existing sign, staff recommends that they work with staff to determine a lighting plan that can be administratively approved.
