





Furthermore, the conditions within the city's jails/justice center have been negatively impacted by COVID-19, which has presented a unique public health risk to incarcerated citizens and law enforcement. I believe that my experience as a Business Analyst in the Healthcare industry allows me to bring analytic solutions to policymaking which can remedy this public health issue in tandem with focusing on substantive policy reforms with respect to keeping formerly incarcerated individuals out of from being incarcerated again.

The company I am employed by specializes in Care Management for Medicare and Medicaid patients - meaning I have subject matter expertise in National and State Medicare & Medicaid policies. Since Virginia has passed and implemented Medicaid Expansion, all citizens that are considered Medicaid eligible are covered by the expansion including those who've been incarcerated.
