- Confirm 25-30' trailers-service comes from Wayne St.
- Not strapped currently, but parking an issue
- Eliminate parking on Wayne St. to make a left
- Wants to keep driveway access from Cutshaw Trucks come from west and enter off Cutshaw. They Exit off Wayne St.- to West Broad Street
- One-Way west would make them circle the block, and access from the alley.
- Will the City make them use the alley access only?
- Will this work for truck access?

- Would like the City to consider closing a portion of alley for through traffic.
- Want to maintain access along North Belmont Ave. and alley.
- Concerned with traffic and access to their development from the alley.
- Will development Low Density along W. Grace St., Mixed Use High Density on northern parcel, along Cutshaw.
- City explained one-way west, to eliminate conflict at WBS, EB traffic merge. It's currently too close to intersection.
- Will follow-up with DPW regarding options for Alley and making it wider and more conducive for this developments use.
