That the Council hereby requests that the Chief Administrative Officer cause to be prepared a plan that provides for the achievement of the objectives for broadband accessibility and affordability within the city of Richmond set forth in this resolution, including the designation of a coordinator of broadband telecommunications resources for the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That the Council hereby requests that the plan for which this resolution calls include the following objectives, to the extent permitted by law:

- 1. Oversight and coordination by the broadband telecommunications resources coordinator designated by the Chief Administrative Officer of efforts and initiatives designed to increase and improve the accessibility and affordability of broadband for all residents of the city of Richmond.
- 2. Establishment and coordination of contracting services for designing and implementing a citywide broadband network for the purposes of providing free or reduced-cost service for lower-income residents and students residing within the city of Richmond.

3. Establishment of methods, as determined by a set of need-based metrics, for

providing all students of Richmond Public Schools and their families with affordable access to

broadband.

4. Pursuit of state and federal funds for broadband expansion in areas characterized as

urban and rural in accordance with any applicable state or federal laws, rules, or regulations.

5. Pursuit and management of funds in accordance with the American Rescue Plan

Act of 2021, H.R. 1319, 117th Cong., 1st Sess. (2021-2022) and other federal broadband

infrastructure funding, as necessary, to support the objectives set forth in this resolution.

6. Implementation of plan for a citywide wireless network to allow residents and

visitors of the city of Richmond to easily connect to the internet from anywhere within the city of

Richmond, including the City's parks system.

7. Integration and coordination of the activities of City agencies and departments with

internet service providers offering service or potentially offering broadband service within the

city of Richmond.

ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY

Patron request that legislation be drafted requesting that the CAO ensure that objectives and tasks listed below are achieved concerning the availability and affordability of broadband in the City are met.

- That a primary point of contact for broadband issues be determined;
- That efforts and initiatives to increase the availability of broadband for all Richmond residents are overseen and coordinated in the City government;
- That efforts to improve affordability of broadband for all Richmond residents are coordinated and overseen;

- That coordination of contracting services for designing and implementing a citywide broadband network for the purposes of providing free or reduced-cost service for lower-income residents and students be established;
- That methods of providing all of the city's school students and families, as determined by a set of need-based metrics be established;
- That the City pursue State and Federal funding sources for broadband expansion in urban and rural area;
- That the City pursue and managing funding from the American Rescue Plan Act and other federal broadband infrastructure funding, as necessary, to support these efforts;
- That the City plan and implement a citywide wireless network to allow residents and visitors to easily connect to the internet from anywhere in the city, including Richmond's parks system; and
- That activities among different city agencies and departments and coordinating with Internet service providers offering service or potentially offering service in the City be integrated.

The legislation should also direct all other agencies to support the efforts to improve affordability and access to broadband in the City be coordinated.

BACKGROUND

The patron hopes that this legislation will led to a coordinated effort to effectively leverage City resources to pursue initiatives to provide affordable, reliable, and accessible internet service to all communities in the City.

Note: That the Commonwealth of Virginia has designated an official, known as the Broadband Chief Advisor to coordinate use of the State's resources at Virginia Code "§ 2.2-205.2.
