Furthermore, the conditions within the city's jails/justice center have been negatively impacted by COVID-19, which has presented a unique public health risk to incarcerated citizens and law enforcement. I believe that my experience as a Business Analyst in the Healthcare industry allows me to bring analytic solutions to policymaking which can remedy this public health issue - in tandem with focusing on substantive policy reforms with respect to keeping formerly incarcerated individuals out of from being incarcerated again.

The company I am employed by specializes in Care Management for Medicare and Medicaid patients - meaning I have subject matter expertise in National and State Medicare & Medicaid policies. Since Virginia has passed and implemented Medicaid Expansion, all citizens that are considered Medicaid eligible are covered by the expansion - including those who've been incarcerated.
