

PURPOSE: To authorize the Acting Chief Administrative Officer, on behalf of the City of Richmond, to accept and appropriate funds in the amount of \$75,000.00 from the NFL Washington Football Team for renovations of outdoor recreation amenities at Hotchkiss Community Center.

REASON: The City of Richmond Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities (PRCF) recognizes the benefit of enhancing and renovating facilities for greater recreation experiences for citizens and visitors.

RECOMMENDATION: Amend the Capital Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022 for the purpose of appropriating this \$75,000 to the Community Center Enhancement project (107068 – CC Enhancement) in the Culture and Recreation category for Hotchkiss Community Center enhancements and the adoption of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND: The City of Richmond and the NFL Washington Football Team has had a relationship for the past decade. The team moved their training camp to Richmond in 2013 and utilized the Bon Secours facility through 2019. This year, the Washington Football Team was in Richmond for a limited engagement from July 27 through July 31 to supplement not hosting Training Camp in 2020. With a strong commitment to the city and the fans in the region over the years, the Washington Football Team is continuing its community outreach with this donation to assist in the renovations of Hotchkiss Community Center.
