THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, be and is hereby authorized to execute an Agreement between City of Richmond and Richmond Metropolitan Transportation Authority Regarding the Kanawha Canal Stones for the purpose of allowing the City to use certain canal stones in connection with improvements to The Low Line park in the city of Richmond. The Agreement between City of Richmond and Richmond Metropolitan Transportation Authority Regarding the Kanawha Canal Stones shall be approved as to form by the City Attorney and shall be substantially in the form of the document attached to this ordinance. § 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
