To amend City Code § 11-102, concerning unlawful dumping, for the purpose of including a prohibition against dumping yard waste on public and private property.

## THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That section 11-102 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2020) is hereby **amended** as follows:

## Sec. 11-102. Unlawful dumping.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to dump or otherwise dispose of trash, garbage, refuse, litter, junk, demolition materials, hazardous wastes, <u>yard waste</u>, or other offensive, unwholesome, unsightly, unsanitary or unhealthy substances on public property, including in any waters within the City, a public highway, drainage ditch, culvert, pipe, storm drain, right-of-way, property adjacent to such highway or right-of-way, or on private property, without the written consent of the owner thereof or the owner's agent.
- (b) Any person convicted of violating this section shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$2,500.00 or confinement in jail for not more than 12 months, or both
