THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the Chief Administrative Officer, for an on behalf of the City of Richmond, is hereby authorized to accept a donation of services in the form of labor and materials valued at approximately \$3,728,327.00 from the Friends of the Richmond Mounted Squad for the purpose of constructing a new equine facility and related amenities located at 601 North 39<sup>th</sup> Street in the city of Richmond.

§ 2. That the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, is hereby authorized to execute a Gift and Right-of-Entry Agreement between the City and the Friends of the Richmond Mounted Squad in

connection with the acceptance of the gift authorized by section 1 of this ordinance; provided that such Gift and Right-of-Entry Agreement must first be approved as to form by the City Attorney and must be substantially in the form of the document attached to this ordinance.

§ 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
