**City Council** 

§ 1. That section 24-63 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015) be and is hereby **amended** and reordained as follows:

#### Sec. 24-63. Permit fees.

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[Except as otherwise specifically provided, permits issued in accordance with] Each permit issued under this article [shall be elassified under one of five elasses, as determined by the Director, and] is subject to the applicable fee [as] set forth in Appendix A to this Code [for the respective elass shall]. The fee for a permit for which the fee is not associated with another section of this article in Appendix A to this Code is as set forth for this section in Appendix A to this Code. The applicable fee set forth in Appendix A to this Code must be paid at the time [of] the application for [a] the permit is submitted to the City.
