WHEREAS, the City Council has received a request dated December 5, 2018, from the Chief of Police, representing the City's Department of Police, for concurrent jurisdiction by the City's Department of Police and the campus police force of Virginia Commonwealth University in the areas designated in the map entitled "VCU Proposed Expanded Jurisdiction," and undated;

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the City Attorney, on behalf of the City Council of the City of Richmond, is authorized to file an appropriate petition pursuant to section 23.1-815(B)(iv) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, for concurrent jurisdiction by the City's Department of Police and the campus police force of Virginia Commonwealth University in the areas designated in the map entitled "VCU Proposed Expanded Jurisdiction,"

and undated, and to take such steps as may be necessary to secure approval by the Circuit Court of the City of Richmond of such petition.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
